Where makers drink coffee as part of a tribe.



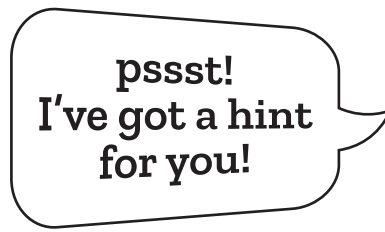
Wicked Cool Cat #8
